### Agenda Items:

- OMPP: Volunteers needed to distribute Provider Guides. Provider survey is still active. Linda mentioned that some survey questions are not applicable to pharmacists- can this be modified?
- Needs Assessment: Need ideas for locations of listening sessions. It is important to reach all corners of the population. Survey questions. (Refer to Poverty Amidst Plenty survey. Dr. Pam Brown. Is it possible to partner with this group for survey distribution?)
- Responsible Beverage Service Training (TiPS): Deale Elks to host a training for South County restaurants. Training will be scheduled for early November on a Monday. Date to be determined. Police or fire to deliver Narcan Training during TiPS. (Rick Brookman).
- Narcan Training: Poor attendance at monthly virtual training sessions. Current promotions are through Mailchimp campaigns and social media. Suggestions to improve the responses for registrations include publishing a free ad in the Bay Weekly paper and/or the Capital. Angel can "boost" social media posts through Serenity Sistas. Flyers can be printed and added to the prevention toolkit. Printed flyers can be distributed with provider guides. Advertise on bathroom doors- vendor is called Idletime. Look into the cost for this.
- Prevention Toolkit: Having missed the dates to distribute at Back to School nights, we will now reach out to PTA for ideas on distributing after the first marking period has ended.
- Capacity building: Reach out via email/ phone to members we haven't seen in a while. We are in-person again! Link social media accounts to others in South County (South County Bulletin Board). Plan December meeting to be an event with a speaker. Linda will look into having it at Pirate's Cove.
- Red Ribbon Week October 23 – 31. Deale Elks is supplying red ribbons. Mindi, Linda, Leslie, and Katie will connect on delivering ribbons to SADD chapters.
