Marijuana Prevention Subcommittee Tasks

1. Collect data related to the risks, long & short term, associated with marijuana consumption, specifically youth consumption, include data source
2. Gather information on the types of devices used for marijuana consumption
 - a. Where are these sold locally (include name of business & address)
3. Compile list of state laws & regulations related to recreational marijuana sale, purchase, consumption & travel/driving (different by city/county vs state-wide)
4. List local dispensaries & research best practices for dispensaries (focus in Annapolis area, ultimately we will want to look at entire AACo)
 - a. Consequences for dispensaries selling to underage; compliance checks?
5. Collect information and/or data related to medical marijuana for youth (under 21), i.e. how to obtain, reason for rx, benefits, alternatives, school policy
